



A RESOLUTION BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF PLANTATION OAK HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION OF BREVARD COUNTY, INC., ESTABLISHING RULES GOVERNING THE USE OF THE RV/BOAT STORAGE FACILITY

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Plantation Oaks Homeowners Association of Brevard County, Inc. in accordance with Article VII, Section 1 A of the By-Laws of the Association, the Board of Administration set the following rules for use of the RV/Boat Storage Facility:

1. One space per homeowner; the homeowner must live in the community; no renters will be permitted to use the lot.
2. All vehicles must have a current registration to the homeowner and have insurance as required by state law.
3. No commercial vehicles or equipment.
4. If the home is sold, the space is gone (it is not transferable to the new owner).
5. Space will have to be forfeited for non-payment after 90 days.

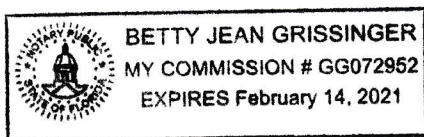
